#### **Case Studies/Scenarios for Plagiarism Workshop**

## <u>Case 1</u>

Patrick, a student in his final trimester of a Diploma was given a mark of 0 for an assignment submitted in Week 12 of the trimester. The lecturer was very experienced and considered it a fairly clear-cut case of cheating, in which the student had used another student's assignment. Turnitin had identified a significant match to a past student's assignment. The lecturer concluded that the student had sourced the assignment and copied it with some changes.

On further investigation, Patrick was able to provide copies of several hard copy sources which he had used in his essay – the same sources used in the original essay matched on Turnitin. While there were definitely some shortcomings in the referencing of both essays, Patrick was able to demonstrate an understanding of the material and evidence of his references.

### Case 2

A student in her second trimester submitted an assignment which at face value would score a very high mark – around a 26/30. It was very well written, showed understanding of the topic and subject content and was correctly referenced.

The student's spoken English was poor and she had scored poorly in class quizzes and activities. The lecturer was surprised at the level of written English in the assignment. Turnitin did not reveal any plagiarism, so the lecturer returned the assignment and recorded the mark on Moodle. Subsequently, the student's exam score was extremely low. A Plagiarism Report should have been submitted.

# <u>Case 3</u>

An assignment submitted via Turnitin by one of your students has identified a 100% match to an assignment submitted in another class to a different lecturer. The student is in his first trimester of Certificate.
