Book Buzz

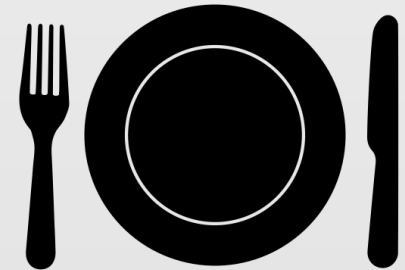
An early literacy program designed to encourage reading in children under five and inspire their families and carers to get involved. Some *Book Buzz* books are translated into first language.

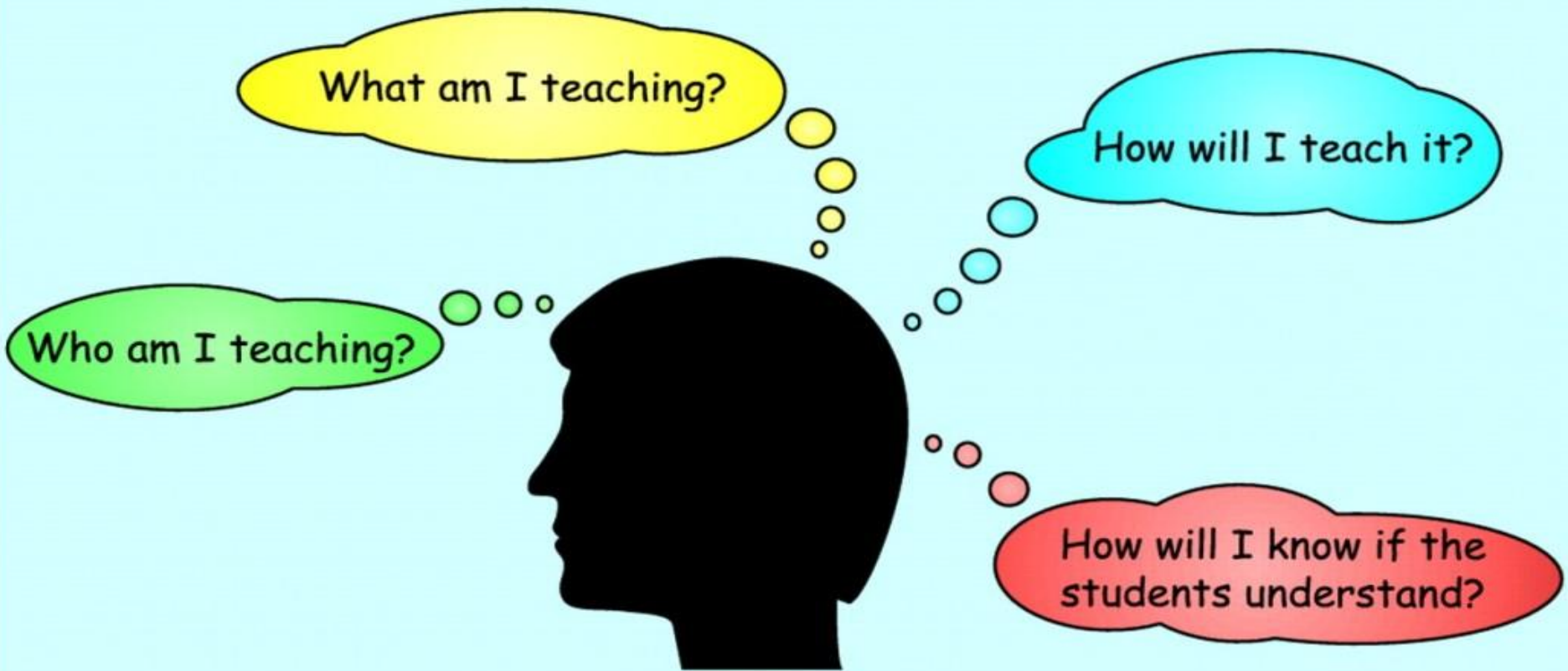

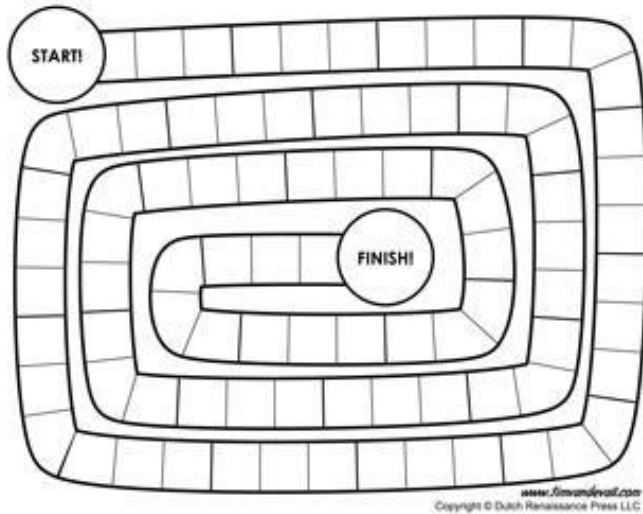

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The Pencil Case Challenge

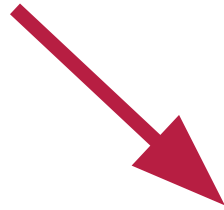
TAKE HOME....
