

Building in Navitas Core Moodle

Learning and Teaching Services

Duration: 5 weeks

Mode(s) of delivery: Online

Live Sessions: Throughout the course, there will be weekly live sessions which will be recorded.

Workload: 15 hours over a 5-week period

Introduction

This 5-week course introduces you to the features and functions of Navitas Core Moodle. Learn how to use this versatile learning management system to enhance the learning experiences of your students. You will create a fit-for-purpose activity in Moodle to address a learning and teaching issue. At the end of the course, you will showcase your Moodle solution and receive feedback from your peers. This feedback will help to inform the ways you go about designing your courses. Upon successful completion of the course, you will receive a **Certificate of Completion**.

Learning Outcomes

On successful completion of this course, you will be able to:

- Describe your technology-enhanced learning and teaching practices through established frameworks.
- Recognise the pedagogical affordances of the tools on Moodle.
- Create a Moodle solution to address a specific learning and teaching issue.
- Explain key considerations relating to accessibility and navigational issues in regards to your Moodle solution.
- Evaluate your Moodle solution against established criteria and standards.

Course Delivery

You will use a range of Moodle tools during the course, which will be facilitated within Navitas Core Moodle as well as Zoom (for live sessions). You are required to have access to the Internet. A webcam and headset microphone are also required for live sessions.

Target Participants

The course is aimed at staff who are upgrading to the latest Navitas Core Moodle or other staff who would like to learn about the features and functions of this learning platform. The course is a professional development activity available to all staff within Navitas.

Weekly Study Pattern

You are expected to commit a minimum of 15 hours over the 5-week period. On a weekly basis, you will attend or watch a 1 hour live session and engage in 2 hours of pre and post class activities comprised of individual or group activities which will include discussions, submitting material for feedback and providing feedback to other participants.

It is expected that you will be actively engaging in activities each week of the course.
